The Tent of Meeting

Moses' Tent of Meeting

Moses used to pitch a tent outside the camp at some distance. It was called the tent of meeting. Anyone who wished to consult the LORD would go to the tent of meeting outside the camp. (Ex 33:7)



Adornment of the Tent

"Let every artisan among you come and make all that the LORD has commanded: the <u>tabernacle</u>, <u>with its tent</u>, its covering, its clasps, its frames, its bars, its columns, and its pedestals; the ark, with its poles, the cover, and the curtain veil; <u>the table, with its poles</u> and all its utensils, and the showbread; the menorah, with its utensils, the lamps, and the oil for the light; the altar of incense, with its poles; the <u>anointing oil</u>, and the <u>fragrant</u> incense; the entrance curtain for the entrance of the tabernacle; (Ex 35:10-15)


