The Peace

- Priest bringing the peace of God to the community
 - Intercessor, in persona Christi
- "And with your Spirit"
 - Recognition of his office over his individuality
- And with each other
 - "Leave your gift at the altar and be reconciled with your brother" [Mt. 5:24]

- ☐ The Fraction
- ☐ Lamb of God
- ☐ The Suffering Servant of Isaiah chapter 53



Holy Communion

- ☐ The Priest must receive in both species
- Recalls Baptism, prefigures Judgment Day
 - ☐ Sanctifying Grace, single file
- ☐ In Communion: prerequisite
- → Holy: ministry and reception
